Approval of previous meeting minutes motioned by Heather second by John.

Old Business

Facility update – Dave – Started on pitcher warm up areas, there will be a back-stop installed. Morley tackling the batting cage roof. Safety switch for the grill will be looked at and we will get the to “code” fire extinguisher and then we will install the proper electrical parts. Training in concession starts (to be determined). Clubhouse lock will be changed to a regular lock.

Scorekeeping clinics - Mar 31st, was change to a little later, April 9th 2015 Rookie Minors and up. Coordinators and coaches? Will need to attend. Morley will put on. Hopefully Krista will also be there.

Umpires - Colten Craig is Morley's mentor this year (he will be support for the umps). Everyone is setup for training. More experienced umpires will ump older kids and vice versa. Morley would like to see a three man system for each game. This weekend there are umping clinics at Layritz.

Prospect (Tournament) Teams – Coaches and Manager applications for Prospects will be asked for next week. Deadline is set for opening ceremonies to have them handed in. President selects the Managers and the board has to approve. You have to be rostered as a Manager or Coach already in Majors or Minors to be an applicant. Teams will run most of the season. We may fill the teams with up to 24 players. We have the ability to travel to other BC Minor parks and/or many tournaments.

Opening Ceremonies - This is all organized, Pancakes 9 to 1030. Concession open at 10am. 9-1030 *hit, pitch, and run* 5- 14 – include all ages- as long as they are registered in CSLL. Hit Pitch and Run have to register names for volunteering. Morley will delegate jobs so we can run this successfully. He will send an email out to Coordinators so they can send to parents for volunteers. (18 people). Ceremonies start and we will have a League Photo, ceremonial pitch, anthem, clothing sales under tent and more. We will need volunteers. Popcorn machine Marti will bring it. Games start right away. Games2U will be there with the Hamsterballs, Video Trailer and games etc. (12 to 3). They are trading sponsorship for the days rentals.

Mascots, Harvey and Turbo will be there. Maybe book them a year ahead for next year. Central Saanich Fire Department will come with their ladder truck. Concession shifts available...
Marti will contact the food bank to get bins. We will promote food donations with the opening ceremonies. Sidney Food Bank is in desperate need for donations.
