- D7 Summer Baseball (for teams that don't advance to tournament)
 - Worked well for MIN, hopeful to include MAJ next season
- D7 Fall Ball
 - o Not promoted this year, MIN wasn't able to proceed, but MAJ did
 - Growing support across D7
- 2020 Softball
 - Interest to dual roster with Extreme for MAJ
 - Allows access to World Series
 - Not intended to poach kids from softball supplementary opportunity to play more ball

- Require 'house program' approach, fees have to offset cost, consider additional league games for scheduling
 - May run into issues with team numbers due to Layritz/CS catchment areas
 - Umpire availability shouldn't be an issue
- No impact to CSLL that Babe Ruth program would cause can be accommodated within existing structure
- o Defer MIN division promotion until interest exists
- 2020 registration fees
 - CSLL has lowest fees across D7 (mainly due to having smaller park maintenance expenses)
 - Last fee increase 2017, prior increase >9 yr ago
 - <5 families require financial support at current rates</p>
 - o Increase would help offset training facility expenditure
 - Recommend keeping MM/RM and MIN/MAJ fees consistent to facilitate assessment assignments
