### **APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

#### **BUSINESS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES**

- Member survey
  - Most respondents indicated availability for summer season
  - Primary concerns for precautions involved hand sanitizer, equipment sharing, and cleaning protocols
  - Most were in favour of deferring or donating registration fees

### **NEW BUSINESS**

- COVID sport continuity plan discuss ideas around potential modifications to the game to reduce risk of COVID-19 transmission
  - o Facility Operations Park Management Plan (eg: sanitizer in dugout)
  - Participants Athlete and Coach/Leader Numbers, Protocols and Checklists (eg: no interlocking games, plate umpire behind pitcher, how to keep kids apart 6' in dugout, forced plays only/no tagging)
  - Sport Programming/Recreation and Skills Lesson/Activity Plans and Management of Equipment (eg: shared bats, baseballs)
    - LLBC cancelled tournaments, sent preliminary conditions list which is arguably unfeasible
    - ViaSPORT is working to prepare revised plan, will not be ready in time for June
- Updated budget
  - ~\$112K revenue with registration fees and gaming grant, concession income removed
  - Sufficient to cover remaining training facility expenses, potential loss of a few thousand if gaming grant not received
  - Discussion around profit/loss and refund potential
    - Ability to offer partial/full refunds for those facing financial hardship (estimated 20% based on survey responses), otherwise planning to hold fees in anticipation of next year's season

- Assuming income predictions are met for next year, would run an estimated profit of \$7K in 2020/21 based on other income sources (other than registration fees)
- Gaming grant status
- Capital grant application for:
  - D6 expansion/scoreboard OR
  - Reapply for training centre
    - Denied last year on grounds CSLL didn't appear to have sufficient funds to complete, now project is nearly complete & paid for and may not qualify
    - Find out if prior refusal would automatically prevent consideration
    - Expect grant eligibility for either project would still require CSLL to be able to demonstrate funding capacity
- Sponsorship
  - Some sponsors have purchased banners, but we have been holding mounting banners until season starts (District Central Saanich supports putting them up in advance)

Motion to put sponsorship banners up now by Cory, second by Clint - Carried
