President's Report

- Registration starts Dec 1
 - Jill working on flyers to go into schools and preschools for early January
 - \circ Jill to contact Panorama in early Jan to post registration on electronic message board by road Free
 - Tia needs to post to website/social media in November (ie only 10 days until registration opens!)
 - Kimberley still willing to help and may be able to drive content spread
 - Employ parents to submit images/video
 - o Morley will email previous members, will identify registration dates
 - Advertise \$840 for 2 banners in PNR or \$550 for 1/3 page in Island Parent: value in doing?
 - No stats on Island Parent effectiveness last year
 - Moe will inquire with Panorama Rec for advertising space, and PNR re news story (eg: training facility, COVID season success)
 - Online need platform if we do this: Cost? (2-3% of registrations)
 - Paypal, Elavon, Square
 - Layritz had unexpected surcharges for processing registration refunds
 - Previous online form wasn't compatible across all browsers
 - TeamSnap & similar apps have significant annual fees
 - Potentially support fillable pdf/scan with e-transfer

- Development Plan what stage of planning are we at for:
 - Players JR/SR overview completed, working to create breakdown for delivery to coaches
 - Coaches CS development YouTube for reference on drills
 - Focus on developing pitchers, catchers and general gameplay knowledge
 - Offer 15-minute sessions to discuss specific topics
 - Offer multiple coach meetings that provide hands-on drills instruction, open broadly to parents interested in playing with kids at home
 - Potentially offer 3rd coaching volunteer exemption in lower divisions (total 4/team) particularly due to elimination of 50:50 and reduced concession operations – need to ensure minimum 8hr requirement met
