- Little League updates:

 - o LLBC is on hold for Provincials but asking leagues if they would participate to gauge interest
 - LLBC meeting last Saturday. Moe advised of Summer Baseball program we initiated in 2019 Other Districts in BC going to their boards to discuss doing also

Concession

- Concession cleaned
- o COVID plan accepted by District of Central Saanich
- o VIHA to inspect last week of March to provide permit to operate
- Crest Fire to inspect extinguishers
- Moe to get plexiglass shield for front counter
- o Members emailed to fill volunteer spots, 57 of 110 filled as of today
 - 358 members less 52 BB, 20 Board, 28 exemptions, 128 team exemptions (4 per team TB and up) = 134 spots to fill other duties incl Pitch/Hit/Run, weeding around Training Facility
 - Not planning 50:50, and Concession only permits 1 volunteer due to COVID spacing requirements, currently limiting 1 shift/family
- o Staff training on Mar 20th from 1-5pm
- o Open Mon-Thu plus Sat
- 3 Cash staff 2 shifts each/wk
- o 2 Grill staff 3 shifts each/wk (one more to hire have interview setup)
- Employment forms being returned now
- o Initial purchase order to take place next week by team effort

Equipment

- o Purchased a pile of new equipment including helmets, catchers gear and bats
- We will be over budget adding new teams but nothing crazy (~\$8K vs \$6K budget due to add'l teams)
- o Bags ready to go by next week

Uniforms

- o Added two MM sets which are supposed to be here by month-end
- Second JUN set (Black) is ready for pickup
- New hats will be handed out to players RM/up players only this year, older style will be distributed to coaches to use up stock
- o Consider having separate inventory of baseballs for training facility, currently 48 doz for season

Treasurer's Report

- Record registrations are apparent in recognized revenue
- Training Facility revenue ahead of budget, with plans for add'l spring break camps
- Flagging ~\$8K deposits paid in cash and deferred registrations that will need to be returned end of season
- Member loans have all been repaid
