- Policies package defer to next meeting
 - o Procurement Committee to be added to Bylaws defer to 2023 AGM

- Coach (team manager) registration fees
 - o Interest has been raised repeatedly for both regular season and off-season registration fees exemptions
 - Unclear on the level of importance broadly across coaching volunteers
 - Would result in increased fees for other players
 - Could result in modified behaviours and encourage volunteers who are only interested in financial benefit (and lack commitment to player development)
 - Potential options include % reductions based on # of seasons coached/year, or straight % fee reduction, or limiting exemptions to off-season or limited commitments (eg: tournament teams) where engagement is more difficult
 - Alternatively (or possibly additionally) consider public recognition and league merchandise for particularly dedicated individuals

Motion to apply 50% discount to tournament team coaching volunteers (up to 4 per team) by Paula, second by Cory – Carried

o Trial for 2023 year

NEW BUSINESS

- Development clinic payment collections
 - o Only 9 players' fees remain outstanding
 - Add fees as an outstanding balance for next season registration
 - o Moving forward, Team Snap registration will require payment up front

- Opening Ceremonies
 - o Apr 8th is Easter weekend change to start on 10th and opening 15th
 - Fields closed until Apr 7th
 - o Change online opening volunteer shifts updated online
 - CS Lions pancake breakfast discounted group rate, incl in budget
 - o PHR & HRD booked
- Assessments scheduled Mar 4th
 - O Draft process ensures teams are balanced, player friend requests are addressed afterward based on assessed skill levels
- LL Victoria D7
 - Victoria long weekend MIN & MAJ fun tournaments
 - o City MIN June 19-24 @ CSLL will require 2 diamonds on weeknights
 - o City MAJ is there an interest? Run same time as City MIN
 - o District MIN Jul 1-9 @ Lakehill
 - o District MAJ Jul 8-16 @ National
 - o Provincial MIN Jul 15-23 @ TBD
 - o Provincial MAJ Jul 22-29 @ TBD
 - JR typically 2nd week of Jul
 - Interlocking MIN and/or MAJ?
 - Anticipate 8 MIN teams
 - Option to select interlock leagues (in response to objectionable rules interpretation concerns) and day of week (in response to concerns of weeknight burden on parents)
 - Might be beneficial for MIN prospects/tournament team, but better to simply verbally prepare
 City players and coaches toward end of regular season
 - 4 MAJ teams, better suited skill level to introduce interlock, particularly given comparatively lower number of teams

- Concession
 - Original pop cooler broke down and can't be repaired, require replacement

 budget \$3,000, new \$4,500
 - Prefer to purchase new vs used
 - o Cabinets being built
 - Staff recruitment salaries \$17 front end; \$19 grill
 - Returning staff typically receive extra \$1
 - letters to Stelly's and social media Feb 1
 - prefer 16-17 yr olds, M-Th, Sa, limited hours Su
 - o Increasing challenge with limited grill capacity to address growing demand
 - o Consider express line on Sa for non-grill items, outside grill for hotdogs

 - o 69 Winter Clinic player registration, more coaches needed
