President's Report

- Registration
 - 480 kids registered (BB 54, TB 130, MM 139, MIN 72, MAJ 37, JUN 36, SEN 12)
 - \circ ALL players should have been contacted by now. Please make sure coaches have done so
 - o Discuss moving to 1 practice and 1 game for Minors and Majors next season
 - Prospects would add a 2nd practice for those who wish to attend more
 - Would this help to retain more kids with parents enrolling them in multiple activities?
 - Could run season Apr Jun then stop for 3wk tournament then restart Jul-Aug OR run sandlot Jul Aug plus summer baseball to get feel for demand
 - Would suggest running Mon-Thu in summer so weekends are free
 - No extra cost to registration
 - Run a sandlot program in 2023 (Minors and Majors) to evaluate interest in a summer program
 - Current Prospect enrollment (max 15 & 15) 15 Minors (9-10) and 14 Majors (11-12)
 - o 2024 move to NO in-person registration as volunteers don't commit and limited signups
- Volunteers
 - 480 total 54 BB 70 paid exemption (43 teams x 4 exemptions/team) 20 board = 164 positions
 - 60 of 186 positions filled so far
 - Over 100 people have not signed up yet
